

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) is hereby made and entered by the:

- 1) Korea TESOL
- 2) The Korea English Extensive Reading Association (KEERA)

A. PURPOSE

To establish a framework for the Organizations to work together in a cooperative manner on issues regarding the development and enhancement of English education in Korea.

B. STATEMENT OF MUTUAL BENEFITS AND INTERESTS

Both Korea TESOL and KEERA aim to support English education and provide professional development opportunities to their respective members and to the larger English language education community in Korea. To this end, the two organizations intend to cooperate in the following ways:


1. Non-financial support for events sponsored by either organization – This will take the form of online notice of events sponsored by the partner organization. Other forms of non-financial support can be discussed and mutually agreed upon.
2. Exchange of speakers – Provide one presentation slot for the partner organization at their main international conference.
3. International conference recognition – Each organization will provide a banner for the partner organization for display at the opening ceremony of their annual international conference. The president will be formally acknowledged during the opening ceremony and introduced as a partner organization.

4. Hold an annual meeting to discuss ways to enhance relationship and explore further ways to cooperate.

This MOU will remain in effect until one or both parties inform the other that they wish to terminate the agreement.

The parties duly execute this Memorandum Of Understanding by their duly authorized officials:


