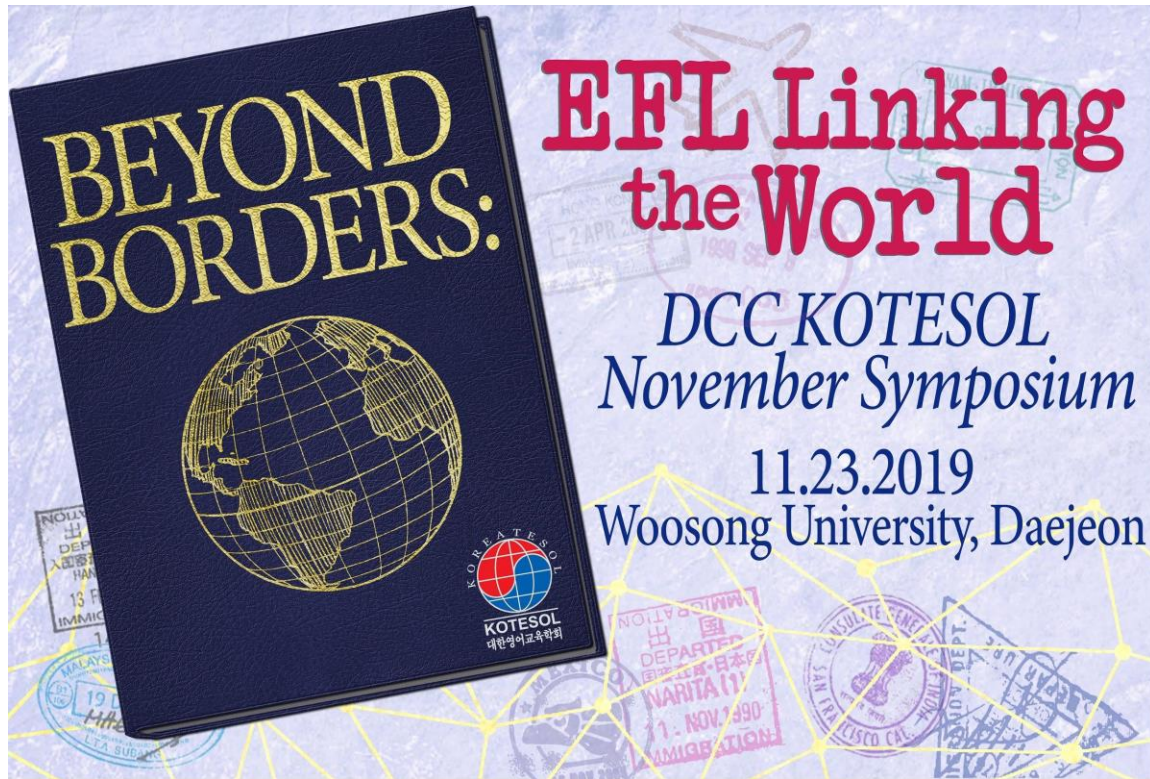

## Types of Presentations

- **Research presentation** - 20 minutes, maximum 2 presenters
  - Short introduction
  - Literature review
  - Methodology
  - Results
  - Discussion
- **Epik/K-12/Hagwon Teaching Demonstration** - 40 minutes, maximum 2 presenters
  - Indicate school level (e.g. kindergarten, elementary, middle, high)
  - Allow participation from audience
  - Give teaching ideas
  - Indicate skills, e.g. reading, writing, listening, speaking
- **Classroom Presentation** - 40 minutes, maximum 2 presenters
  - Indicate level (e.g. elementary, middle, high, university)
  - Allow participation from audience
  - Give teaching ideas
  - Indicate skills, e.g. reading, writing, listening, speaking
- **Workshop** - 40 minutes, maximum 2 presenters
  - Lifestyle skills for the EFL teacher or Teaching resources (any topic as indicated above)
  - Allow participation from audience
- **Poster Session:** A visual display for sharing ideas, projects, and/or research which allows for short and informal discussion between attendees as they circulate within the poster-session area. Note: No A/V equipment is available.

## How to Submit Your Proposal

Submit your proposal on the web page at [2019 DCC Symposium Proposals](#) before

Monday, 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2019 end of day.

You may submit more than one proposal. Complete a new Form for each proposal.

Prepare the information for your proposal beforehand and insert (copy-paste) it into the Proposal Form. Proposals must include:

- **Your current school/institution**
- **Your full name**
- **Your email address**
- **Your nationality**
- **Type of presentation**
  - Research presentation - 20 minutes, maximum 2 presenters
  - Epik/K-12/Hagwon Teaching Demonstration - 40 minutes, maximum 2 presenters
  - Classroom Presentation - 40 minutes, maximum 2 presenters
  - Workshop - 40 minutes, maximum 2 presenters
- **What level teacher is targeted with your proposal?**
  - Kindergarten
  - Elementary
  - Middle School
  - High School
  - University
  - Adult
- **Title of Proposal**
  - Title should be 20 words or less
  - Keep the title short and attractive
  - Capitalize the first word of the title
  - Capitalize all major words (nouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs, and pronouns) in the title, including the second part of hyphenated major words (e.g., Self-Report not Self-report)
  - Capitalize all words of four letters or more
- **Abstract**
  - Give a 200-250 word summary of the presentation/workshop
  - Summarize key issues and provide readers an incentive to attend
  - Describe what participants will do in the workshop/presentation
- **50 to 150-word biodata**
  - Give your full names, highest qualification and affiliation(s)
  - Describe your teaching/research interests and experience

**Proposal submission deadline:** Monday, 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2019 23h59 (Any submission after the deadline will be placed on a reserve list)

**Acceptance decision:** Proposal will be reviewed by the selection committee and those who submitted a proposal will be notified by 30<sup>th</sup> September 2019.

## **Presenter Registration**
