## Korea TESOL Journal Submission Checklist

Here is a convenient checklist to complete in making a submission to the Korea TESOL Journal. □ I have read the Korea TESOL Journal (KTJ) call for papers and submission guidelines. Available at https://koreatesol.org/content/call-papers-korea-tesol-journal □ I have read the Korea TESOL Ethical Standards for Research and Publication. Available at https://koreatesol.org/content/kotesol-ethical-standards-research-and-publication □ I have followed APA Style Guidelines (7th edition) in creating your research manuscript especially for tables, figures, in-text citations, and reference list items? □ I have familiarized myself with the KTJ General Guidelines and Style Guidelines, which include items that are specific to KTJ (and possibly different from APA. Available at https://koreatesol.org/content/call-papers-korea-tesol-journal □ I have included both an abstract and an introduction in my manuscript. □ I have included keywords following my abstract (no more than 10 words in total). □ I have included a biosketch of about 50 words, which includes my email address at the end of the text, after the Conclusions section and just before the reference list, following the model for biosketches. □ I have created all tables with the Word table-making tools rather than creating graphic files (following KTJ style guidelines). □ I have proofread my manuscript for grammar, punctuation, capitalization, and spelling mistakes (following APA and KTJ style guidelines). □ I have checked that each item in the reference list also has at least one corresponding in-text citation, and I have also checked that each in-text citation is also listed in full in the reference list. □ I have **not** used the formatting function that inserts footnotes at the bottom of the page where the footnoted text appears. Instead, I have placed any footnotes at the end of my manuscript, following the reference list. (N.B. Footnotes are not encouraged.) □ I have not used the in-text citation function that links an in-text citation to its reference in the reference list. □ I have included my declaration that my manuscript is original, has not been published before, and is not currently being considered for publication elsewhere. □ I am a KOTESOL member. I have checked that my paid membership is current. (Any accepted manuscript can only be considered as "provisional acceptance" until current, paid membership is confirmed.) □ I have submitted a signed KTJ Copyright Agreement with my manuscript. (Any accepted manuscript can only be considered as "provisional acceptance" until a completed copyright agreement is received by the editors from the single author, or each co-author.) □ I have checked that I have adhered to each of the items listed in this checklist. — Not sure of something on, or not on, this checklist?
