Allison Bill - IOC / Jeonju President

- Lindsay Herron represented KOTESOL at MELTA and ELTAM/Mongolia TESOL

- Several organizational partners (FEELTA/MAAL) are currently inactive. We should decide whether to extend partnership.

- 2. Members from outside the chapter will be added to the conference committee to signal that as a national event this conference will receive oversight. Support from outside the chapter may be provided for publicity, registration, and program.

3. The estimated number of attendees will be increased from 50-70 to 100-120. The number of concurrent sessions should also be increased. Advertising this as a larger event will attract sponsorship.
