National Elections 2013: Online and at Conference

KOTESOL's Elections play an important part in shaping the next year of the organization. Votes are important (many offices have been decided by 10 or fewer ballots). Current members as of Conference weekend are eligible to vote online before the conference, or at the conference venue.

- September 22 October 10: *On-line voting* (ballots sent to registered email address)
- October 12 13: On-site voting (at International Conference)
- October 13: *Results announced* (during ABM at International Conference)

* Dates may change without notice.

Membership Expiry

Most KOTESOL members have one-year memberships. As a practical matter, memberships taken out in the pre-registration process for International Conference, or at the international conference venue, expire Sept 30th. This means those "current" members are not eligible for member discounts at this year's conference, are not eligible to vote, and will lose access to current publications, etc.

Annual Business Meeting, Constitution/Bylaws Amendments

The KOTESOL Annual Business Meeting will be held on the 13th of October. A formal notice will be sent to all members on the 13th of September, 2013, to that effect.

Since any proposed amendments to the Constitution or Bylaws of KOTESOL must be included in such a notice, it is vital that they be submitted no later than 12 noon of the 12th of September, 2013. All such amendments must be submitted according to the current bylaws and constitution (e.g., must be signed by 5 current members).
